2023 SOLAR REBATE PROGRAM UPDATE

North Attleborough Electric Department (NAED) Customers who want to install solar panels for home energy use can now apply for a generous incentive of up to \$3,000 through the NAED Solar Rebate Program. NAED has pledged \$60,000 for calendar year 2023. The NAED Solar Rebate Program will award \$0.60 per watt DC for approved projects.

NAED is offering this incentive program to make solar technology more affordable for our Customers to adopt robust renewable energy sources.

Due to high interest in the NAED Solar Rebate Program, rebate amounts will be limited to the first 5,000 watts DC installed in order for more Customers to be able to benefit from this program.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Provides \$0.60 /watt (DC) of installed solar production for the first 5,000 watts installed.

For example: Systems sized for 3,000 watts DC of solar energy production will be eligible for an \$1,800 rebate. Systems sized for 5,000 watts DC can qualify for the maximum of \$3,000.

Only customers with renewable generation systems approved by NAED will qualify to receive this rebate.

Systems must meet the requirements of NAED's Net Metering Tariff (MDPU Tariff #15).

Available to Customers both, Residential or Commercial, with systems up to 25kW AC.

Customers must be the owner of the building or installation site.
